 - Praying for GC and its leaders
 - Receiving impartation and correction when necessary from my leaders
 - Contacting Peter Johnson or Pastor Tim (as soon as I know) if I can't be at GC on a Wednesday night or for a special event – *especially* if I'm scheduled to be on the worship team that night

Procedure for Joining the GC Worship Team

(to play on Wednesday Nights)

1. Attend Generation Church (GC) faithfully.
2. Attend GC Worship Nights faithfully.
3. Demonstrate the fruit of a relationship with Jesus faithfully (Galatians 5:16-25).
4. Complete the GC Worship Team Covenant and hand it in to Peter Johnson.
5. Possibly meet with Peter Johnson and/or Pastor Tim.
6. Be prayerfully approved and accepted on the team by Pastor Tim and Peter Johnson

* We will have standards – both musically and spiritually – that must be met before you will be considered a member of the Wednesday night GC Worship Team.

* This procedure gives strong criteria for entrance onto the GC Worship Team. Please understand that these criteria are built on relationship – between you and Peter Johnson / Pastor Tim / the GC Small Group Leaders. Make sure you work to develop these important relationships!
